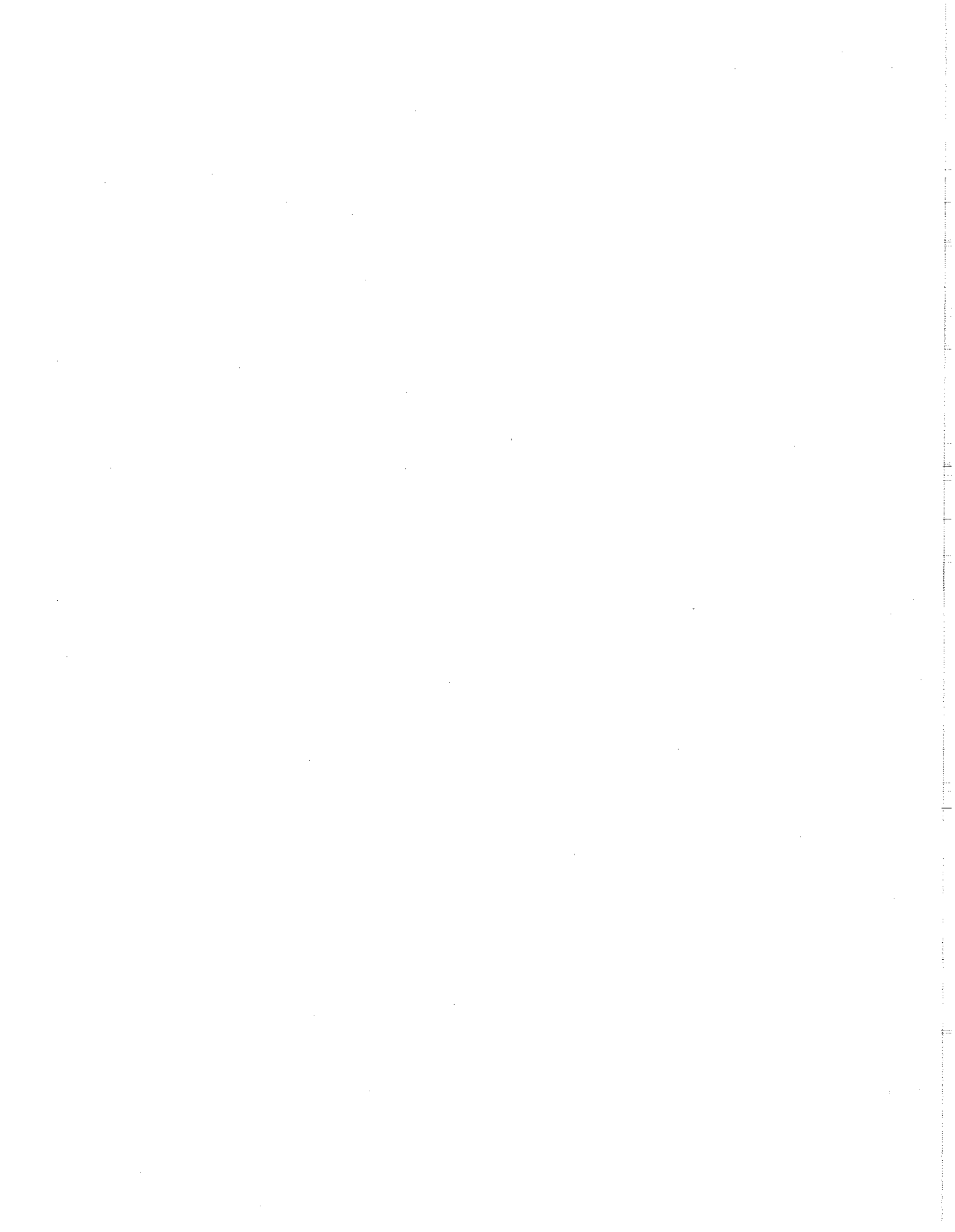

We propose a change in the courses required for the 902 licensure as indicated by the boldface above. We propose that *Instructional Design* and *Advanced Design and Production of Instructional Materials* become alternate courses for each other and the relatively new course *Information, Virtual Libraries and the Internet*, become a required course. We feel this new course adds an important component to the program by delving in greater depth into the organization of information in electronic format. Library media specialists need skills in accessing, organizing, and creating the electronic information structures. The two proposed alternative courses deal with the creation of instructional materials for specific instructional purposes in a school, approaching this design and development work from slightly different perspectives, but we feel the following competencies for the 902 licensure can be achieved through a combination of the last four courses listed above.

PI 3.42 Competencies:

- 2 a) Identification of instructional objectives and selection of a variety of media and other resources to meet those objectives.
- 2 b) Principles and theories of general elementary, middle, and secondary level curriculum development and educational psychology.
- 2 d) Selection and use of microcomputers and appropriate software for educational and bibliographic purposes.
- 2 e) Advanced techniques for producing instructional media in graphic, projected, and electronic formats; ability to determine when to use local school district or commercial production facilities; ability to secure information through networks and computerized databases.
