Manuel Ossers motioned approval of the December 1998 minutes. A second to the motion was made by Marshall Anderson. The motion passed.

Announcements:

2. The application deadline for Graduate Research Grant Applications is Friday, February 19, 1999.
3. The deadline for approving new graduate courses to be published in the Fall 1999 timetable is February 11th.
4. Please comply with the April 8, 1999 Graduate Council meeting as the deadline for approving new graduate courses to appear in the 2000 - 2001 Graduate Bulletin.

Mohammad Ahmadi motioned that the 'Information Only' items be received and recorded. Marshall Anderson seconded the motion which passed. Items to be received and recorded are:

1. Change in credits, contact hours, and requisites of course from Department of Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Coaching: *448-460/660, Organization and Administration of Interscholastic Athletics*, from 3 credits to 2 credits; from no requisites to 448-240, 448-250, 448-255, 448-256, 448-461/661, and two credits of *Coaching/Coaching of courses: 448-350, 448-351, 448-352, 448-355, 448-356, 448-359, 448-360, 448-361.*
2. Change in requisites of course from Department of Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Coaching: *448-461/661 Prevention and Care of Athletic Injuries*, from no requisites to *448-250 Scientific Principles of Coaching.*

Ossers motioned approval of a new course, *448-463/663, Children and Sports* from the Department of Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Coaching. Anderson followed with a second to the motion which passed on council vote.

Brenda O'Beirne motioned that the final business item, creation of a new course, be approved. Mohammad Ahmadi seconded the motion to approve the Department of Counselor Education's new course, *499-797 Post-Master School Counseling Internship*. A short discussion about the title and repeatability of the course ended as the council voted approval.

The meeting ended at 2:45 p.m. after Wade Dazey and Jacqueline Dailey motioned and seconded adjournment.
