

## GRADUATE COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

March 11, 1999

The meeting was called to order at 2:16 p.m. by Richard Lee.

A motion for approval of the February 1999 minutes was given by Manuel Ossers. After a second from Tony Truog, approval was obtained through council vote.

### Announcements--

1. Final Spring 1999 enrollment figures show that 426 FTE matches the 1998 figure.
2. Regarding the Masters in Music Education Program, we will continue to offer classes, but will not admit new students to the program.
3. The policy item for April 1999 meeting will be a business item about the perceived abundance of dual-listed courses at UW-Whitewater. This is the result of the North Central Association's last accreditation visit to campus.
4. The "Peltier Amendment" (after discussion by Richard Telfer and John Stone) resulted in a proposal to be taken by Telfer to the UCC. The proposal reads "If the new syllabus reflects a change in more than 50% of the course content, the course sponsor should complete Curriculum Proposal Form #3 establishing a new course."

Manuel Ossers and Neil Stone teamed up with a motion/second to approve the following items as a group. Approval was attained through council vote. The information only items to be received and recorded are:

1. Change in Licensure of course from Departments of Curriculum and Instruction and Business Education/Office Systems: 439-793, from *Practicum: Business Education 1-6 credits*, to *Practicum: Business Education 3 credits* and *Practicum: Marketing Education 3 credits* (see attached).
2. Change in Title and Number of course from Department of Counselor Education: from 490-723, *Counseling in Elementary and Junior High Schools*, to 490-743, *Counseling in Elementary and Middle Schools* (see attached).
3. Change in Number of course from Department of Counselor Education: from 490-725, *Counseling in Secondary Schools*, to 490-745.
4. Deletion of course from Department of Counselor Education: 490-730, *Consulting Skills for Counselors*.

5. Change in Revision and Description of course from Department of Counselor Education: 490-738, *Perspectives in School Counseling*.
6. Deletion of course from Department of Counselor Education: 490-747, *Consultation Models and Outreach Applications in Student Services*.
7. Change in Revision, Description and Title of course from Department of Languages and Literatures/English: 680-347/547, from *British Literature 1900-1950*, to *British Modernism*.
8. Change in Description and Title of course from Department of Languages and Literatures: 680-348/548, from *American Literature 1900-1950*, to *American Modernism*.
9. Deletion of course from Department of Languages and Literatures: 680-349/549, *Modern American and British Literature: 1950 to Present*.
10. Deletion of course from Department of Languages and Literatures: 680-400/600, *Chaucer*.
11. Change in Revision, Description and Title of course from Department of Languages and Literatures: 680-402/602, from *Renaissance Poetry and Prose*, to *Sixteenth Century British Literature*.
12. Deletion of course from Department of Languages and Literatures: 680-403/603, *Renaissance Drama Excluding Shakespeare*.
13. Deletion of course from Department of Languages and Literatures: 680-406/606, *Milton*.
14. Deletion of course from Department of Languages and Literatures: 680-413/613, *Restoration and Eighteenth Century Theatre and Drama*.
15. Change in Revision, Description and Title of course from Department of Languages and Literatures: 680-414/614, from *Prose and Poetry of the Restoration and 18<sup>th</sup> Century*, to *18<sup>th</sup> Century British Literature*.
16. Deletion of course from Department of Languages and Literatures: 680-486/686, *Senior Seminar in English*.

Business item A received a Tony Truog/Mohammad Ahmadi motion/second for approval. The proposal for creation of a new course from the Department of Health, Physical Education, Recreation, and Coaching: 448-466/666, *Alcohol, Drugs and Sports* was approved.

Business item B, change in degree requirements from Department of Communicative Disorders: *Master of Science in Communicative Disorders* was given a motion for approval by Scott Bradley. After a second by Brenda O'Beirne, the approval was given through council vote.

Business Items C through G were considered as a collective block that resulted from a Tony Truog motion and Brenda O'Beirne second. Council approval followed for:

1. Change in Title and Requirements of Major from Department of Counselor Education: from *Guidance and Counseling to Counseling*.
2. Creation of New Course from Department of Counselor Education: 490-735, *Ethical and Professional Identity Formation*.

3. Creation of New Course from Department of Counselor Education: *490-736, Counseling Across the Lifespan.*
4. Creation of New Course from Department of Counselor Education: *490-750, Consultation in Counseling: An Individual and Systems Approach.*
6. Creation of New Course from Department of Counselor Education: *499-795, Counseling Internship.*

Final items of curricular action (business items) were considered as a group through a Manuel Ossers/Ray Baus motion/second. The three items receiving council approval are:

1. Creation of New Course from Department of Languages and Literatures: *680-342/542, American Realism and Naturalism.*
2. Creation of New Course from Department of Languages and Literatures: *680-401/601, Medieval British Literature.*
3. Creation of New Course from Department of Languages and Literatures: *680-412/612, Seventeenth Century British Literature.*

No other business was brought forward. The meeting adjourned at 2:41 p.m. following a Mohammad Ahmadi motion/Jimmy Peltier second.
