II. Justification

This course was approved by all curricular bodies last year. However, when approved the number of credits indicated were the total for the entire Internship experience, rather than the credit per semester. Counseling students participate in a two semester Internship. All students who began their program after June 1, 1999, will participate in an Internship for three credits for two successive semesters (six credits total). Therefore, there is a need to change the credit per semester to three.

Students who began their program prior to June 1, 1999, have a program which requires them to complete the Internship for six credits per semester for two successive semesters (twelve credits total). In order to allow students to complete their degree program according to their original plan of studies it will be necessary to offer the Internship for six credits per semester.

During this transition time for the counseling program, it will be necessary to allow for variable credit for the Internship to meet the needs of our students.
