ACCOUNT 761 Accounting and Management Information Systems 3 units

A study of theory and principles underlying the design and installation of accounting and management information systems; consideration of the integration and impact of the computer on the total information system.

Prereq: ACCOUNT 244 or ACCOUNT 701.

TO:

ACCOUNT 761 Accounting and Management Information Systems 3 units

This course focuses on theory and principles underlying the design and installation of accounting and management information systems, including an in-depth investigation into internal control structures and the integration and impact of the computer on the total information system.

Prereq: ACCOUNT 244 or ACCOUNT 701, and ACCOUNT 342 or ACCOUNT 725.

II. **Justification for action**

The course description change is minor; it merely aligns the description of this course with the format and structure of the other courses offered by the Accounting Department.

The prerequisite change is consistent with the prerequisite for ACCOUNT 454 (Accounting Information Systems) which is a course similar and compatible to ACCOUNT 761.
