II. **Justification for action**

This course is part of a four-course, six-credit sequence (EDUINDP 724, EDUINDP 726, EDUINDP 727, EDUINDP 789) culminating in the completion of the capstone project in the MSE-PD. Projects vary; course work in EDUINDP 724 includes guided development of a detailed project proposal that constitutes a draft of the first three chapters of a capstone report. Students complete several steps that are evaluated by checking off, for example, whether a student completes a satisfactory chapter draft by a deadline, whether they obtain advisor feedback, or whether they complete a satisfactory review of literature. The Capstone Seminar itself, EDUINDP 789, currently has a Satisfactory/No Credit grade basis. The change will increase the consistency among the capstone courses and will allow the instructor to emphasize the unique requirements of each student's project.
